

# Act 4 of 2001 & ACT 48 of 2003 of the Education Improvement Tax Credit Program

## Pre Kindergarten Program:

**\$5,000,000 set aside for Pre Kindergarten Scholarships**

- ◆ Businesses will receive a 100% credit for the first \$10,000, and up to a 90% credit on the remaining amount of the contribution.
- ◆ Requires only a 1 year commitment!
- ◆ Businesses can apply for up to a \$100,000 in credits.
- ◆ The school must be within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

## K through 12 Program:

**\$26,666,666 set aside for K through 12 Scholarships**

- ◆ \$13,333,333 to Educational Improvement Organizations.
- ◆ Businesses can increase their Credit from \$100,000 to \$200,000 per fiscal year for the K through 12 program.
- ◆ The school must be within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

These are the taxes in which the credit can be applied:

- ◆ Corporate Net Income Tax
- ◆ Bank & Trust Company Shares Tax
- ◆ Insurance Premiums Tax
- ◆ Capital Stock Franchise Tax
- ◆ Title Insurance Company Shares Tax
- ◆ Mutual Thrift Institutions Tax

**A business may apply for a combined total of \$300,000 if they participate in both the Pre Kindergarten & K through 12 programs.**
